Dear Public Safety Professional:

New York City's newly elected administration has signaled its intention to pursue significant shifts in public-safety policy — changes that many in the law-enforcement community believe could have serious consequences for our safety and the well-being of the public we serve. The Detectives' Endowment Association, Inc. (DEA) proposes creation of a unified **New York Public Safety Alliance** to coordinate messaging, legislative strategy, and public engagement among law-enforcement unions and public-safety professionals across the State.

Our mission is clear: to protect the men and women who protect our communities and to ensure that public safety remains a non-negotiable, nonpartisan priority at every government level.

The **New York Public Safety Alliance** will present a unified, Statewide voice for public safety professionals. We will engage policymakers in City Hall, Albany, and Washington, D.C., providing data, statistics, and real-world case examples to ensure their decisions are guided by evidence-based facts. We must educate and engage the public on how anti-police policies endanger every New Yorker and carry real-life consequences.

The DEA proposes to hold an introductory, exploratory meeting beginning at **10:00 a.m. on January 22, 2026**, at Russo's on the Bay, 162-45 Cross Bay Boulevard, Howard Beach, Queens, NY 11414. This will be a closed-door session to adopt a joint declaration and outline our next steps for legislative engagement, including political and public communications.
